



### **Grounds Maintenance Operative**

The Boleskine House Foundation SCIO seeks a Grounds Maintenance Operative to support the maintenance of the Boleskine House Estate. This is a self-employed paid position at £10.50 per hour. The role is for 3-4 hours per week on the estate.

#### **The Role**

The work will involve:

- Grass cutting
- Strimming
- Tree maintenance
- In Autumn, leaf clearance
- Maintenance of fences
- Maintenance of estate CCTV system

The role will be year round and is proposed for the individual to be on a self-employed basis. A UK driving license is required to reach the estate.

All lawn equipment is provided and we will provide training on the use of the machinery.

Your hours can be flexible, with the ability to manage them either each week or every fortnight (weekday or weekend as you prefer) and we anticipate this being a long term role with the potential for expansion once we expand the gardens on the estate.
