



Summer Construction Labourer

The Boleskine House Foundation SCIO seeks a Summer Construction Labourer to work on the rebuild of Boleskine House. This is a self-employed paid position, with pay depending on experience, between £8.72 and £12 per hour. The role is full-time, from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday, with time for a lunch break. The role can continue longer term than the summer if this is desirable for the applicant, but we anticipate the role may appeal to those looking for a summer position.

We are looking for someone who is able to start in this role between mid-end of May if possible, but will also consider those wanting to start later.

The Role

The work will involve:

- Site and rubbish clearance of materials to skips
- Helping to rebuild gables and chimneys, to include running and collecting materials over the site for stonemasons
- Mixing of lime mortar (training provided)
- Movement of scaffolding materials across the site for the professional team
- Assisting with slating the roof, to include help moving slates onto the roof for the slaters

PPE will be provided as well as a full Health and Safety training induction.

We are willing to discuss on site accommodation if this is needed.
